### **MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORT**

We have three (3) new applications for membership, five (5) cancellations and zero (0) terminations for the month of June. Six (6) individuals are on medical leave. Membership receipts for June were \$41,665.18. Pool membership stands at thirty (30) YTD. Forty three (43) members are on the unlimited cart plan. The Drive, Chip and Putt contest scheduled for July 15, 2022 has 70 players.
