**MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORT**

Total income through the month of April for the year was \$272,082.31 while total expenses were \$225,540.98. F. Lee made a motion to accept, B. Bradley seconded, motion carried.

Fred Lee presented membership numbers. The club had 17 new members, 1 cancellations and zero terminations. Four individuals are on medical leave. Membership receipts for the month of May were \$35,385.36 (\$247,039.55 YTD). Current membership stands at 400 paying members with a total membership of 415 members. C. Carter made a motion to accept, J. Alles seconded, motion carried. After discussion among the board, J. Alles made a motion to cap pool memberships at 50 memberships effective 06-14-21. T. Smith seconded; motion carried.

## **PRO SHOP**

A. Webb stated that an employee contest for signing up members on the ACH program has begun. A \$50 gift card is being given to the winner. Total rounds YTD for 2021 are currently 8,000 with member rounds being 6,200.
