J. Holloway called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORT

Minutes from October meeting presented by J Alles. J. Holloway made a motion to accept, seconded by B. Bradley; motion carried. A. Webb presented financials as prepared by A. Webb as of October 21, 2021. Total income through the month of October for the year was \$790,018.86 while total expenses were \$716,324.14. J. Alles made a motion to accept; seconded by J. Holloway; motion carried.

MEMBERSHIP

Cameron Brown presented membership on behalf of Fred Lee. We had four new applications for membership, three cancellations and zero terminations. Five individuals are on medical leave. Membership receipts for June were \$41,337.33. Current membership stands at 413 paying members with a total membership of 429 members. J. Scholl made a motion to accept the membership report; seconded by J. Howell; motion carried.

GOLF COURSE

Bobby Bradley and John English reported that Texas gas has not returned. Plan to replace/repair culvert on hole 14. Plastic will be put down and same procedure followed as was done on hole 16. On hole 3, the irrigation line replaced and put in a 4" drain to protect the pipe. Plans are in place to continue work on expanding some tee boxes. We will level and sod them in the spring. A new ball washer will be put in place on hole 4. Tarps are in and it will enable us to put double tarps on three more greens.

PRO SHOP

Rounds of golf are down by about 500 rounds but member rounds are up by 1880. Golf shop credit is set to expire at the end of the year so we should see an influx in merchandise numbers. The golf shop hours changed to 8am - 4pm on 11/01/2021. We will delay closing on Mondays until the weather gets colder. Since the weather is nice, we have had an increase in rounds of golf.

HOUSE

Julie Alles mentioned that the light in the parking lot near the pool is out and needs to be replaced. It is very dark and people are unable to see the parking curbs that is hazardous. The club will address the lighting issue.

POOL

It was discussed and decided to leave the cover on the pool during the winter. Then in the spring, drain the water and refill it with clean water.

MARKETING

The club is not going to renew the Stay-N-Play with the website online. It costs \$500 per year. Adam state we have not seen that much response and he wants to see how the club does without it. It is only advertised on the Stay-N-Play website.

TOURNAMENTS AND EVENTS

2021 (non-club sponsored events) brought in \$28K. 2021 club sponsored tournaments brought in \$9K.
